Most Dangerous Foods For Dogs

Alcohol: Coma, Death, Intoxication

Avocado: Vomiting, Diarrhea (contains Persin)

Caffeine: Vomiting, Diarrhea (toxic to heart & nervous system)

Chocolate: Death (toxic to heart & nervous system)

Cooked Bones: Stomach lacerations
Dairy: Diarrhea (too much)
Fatty Foods: Pancreatitis (too much)

Grapes: Kidney failure

Medications: Kidney failure, GI Ulcers (Tylenol, Advil, etc.)

Mushrooms: Shock, Death (some varieties)

Onions & Garlic: Blood cell damage, Anemia (too much)

Raisins & Currents: Kidney failure

Walnuts & Macadamias: Nervous system, Muscle damage **Xylitol (Gum, Candy, etc.):** Liver failure, Hypoglycemia, Death
