| <b>Alcohol:</b>                    | Coma, Death, Intoxication                            |
| <b>Avocado:</b>                    | Vomiting, Diarrhea (contains Persin)                 |
| <b>Caffeine:</b>                   | Vomiting, Diarrhea (toxic to heart & nervous system) |
| <b>Chocolate:</b>                  | Death (toxic to heart & nervous system)              |
| <b>Cooked Bones:</b>               | Stomach lacerations                                  |
| <b>Dairy:</b>                      | Diarrhea (too much)                                  |
| <b>Fatty Foods:</b>                | Pancreatitis (too much)                              |
| <b>Grapes:</b>                     | Kidney failure                                       |
| <b>Medications:</b>                | Kidney failure, GI Ulcers (Tylenol, Advil, etc.)     |
| <b>Mushrooms:</b>                  | Shock, Death (some varieties)                        |
| <b>Onions &amp; Garlic:</b>        | Blood cell damage, Anemia (too much)                 |
| <b>Raisins &amp; Currents:</b>     | Kidney failure                                       |
| <b>Walnuts &amp; Macadamias:</b>   | Nervous system, Muscle damage                        |
| <b>Xylitol (Gum, Candy, etc.):</b> | Liver failure, Hypoglycemia, Death                   |
